Practitioners are able to raise a referral for external practitioners to your organisation (i.e., a Referral Out):

- 1. Search for a patient.
- 2. Click Show.
- 3. In the Main Menu, click Referrals.
 - a. Any existing referrals will be visible on the screen, check that the referral hasn't already been added, if it hasn't proceed to the next step.
- 4. Click Referral Out.
- 5. Select **Referral To.**

Note: CareRight requires a provider number recorded against a medical provider to ensure correct referral out for this contact. For an informal referral (non-medical) or LMO referral - see Add a referral for LMO / informal referral (non-medical).

- 6. Complete fields using the table below for reference.
- 7. Click Create Referral.
