Once a diagnosis has been added, it can be edited if required or more diagnosis codes can be added to the existing list.

- 1. Search for a Patient.
- 2. Click Show.
- 3. In the Main Menu, click Admissions.
- 4. From the list of admissions, select the ARN (hyperlink) of the relevant admission.
- 5. Scroll down to Diagnoses.
- $6. \ \ \text{To edit existing diagnosis, select the } \textbf{Edit} \ \text{button next to the relevant diagnoses}.$
- 7. To add new diagnosis, Click New on the list of diagnosis.
