*Further explanation:

- Flavour → CareRight Postgres Typically run by clients with 1-20 users
- Flavour → CareRight MSSQL Typically an Enterprise level solution, run by clients with 20+ users and their own IT Support Department as it requires more complex infrastructure
- Host Type → Internal CareRight runs on a server within your network and is accessed via a network connection
- Host Type → External CareRight runs on a server outside of your network and is accessed
 over the Internet via SSL AKA in the Cloud
