

Replacement Variables Overview

Data from the patient's record can be inserted directly into the Text Editor and used in letters and clinical notes. Replacement variables inputs existing data/ text directly from a Patients record in CareRight.

For example: {Date of Birth} will automatically retrieve the patients date of birth from their record. Replacement variables allow for a single template to be used for all patients.

Replacement Variables are surrounded by curly brackets { VARIABLE NAME } and are inserted via Menu Option: Insert > Replacement Variables:

We have split this section into the four types of Replacement Variables::

- [General](#) - Patient demographics, address, clinical information, admission, administrative, system.
 - [Most Recent Appointment](#) - Fields from the *most recent (today or earlier)* appointment for the patient at the time of letter generation.
 - [Future Appointment](#) - Fields from the *next upcoming appointment* for the patient at the time of letter generation.
 - [Current Appointment](#) - Fields from the *current appointment* for the patient (This is access using the right mouse click on an appointment and selecting Correspondence).
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
