Enable a Problem Codeset

Under **Administration > Patients > Problem Codes**, there is the ability to specify all of the specific codes you wish to

enable.

The simplest way to do so is to select * as a wildcard entry for all available problems.

Problem Code Set Specification

Loading Standard Codes

Enter the codes you wish to be included in the problem code set.

The * character will be treated as a wild card.

You may specify one of the following as a prefix followed by a : .

- GEN (Problem Generic Code)
- ICPC2 (ICPC-2)

Any line without a prefix will be treated as the default code type specified below.

E.g.

A04. *

GEN: 013

You may specify one of the following as a prefix followed by a ':' (colon)

1. GEN (Disease Generic Code) - to load Problem Generic Code (maintained in Generic Codes) type "GEN:" < This will load all Problem generic codes
2. ICPC2 (ICPC-2) - to load all ICPC-2 codes type "ICPC2:", for a subset same as above

If you wish to replace the entire set of codes in the system, select the **Delete all existing codes before importing** checkbox.
