## **Example Settings**

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This article is part of the systems administration guide. You will require administration access to view the pages mentioned in this article.

The bind DN is the domain that you use to for Windows logins followed by \{login\} - see below - may take a bit of trial and error to setup. To test your settings, setup a LDAP user in CareRight (the CareRight username should be the same as their LDAP login).

Then change the settings in Global Settings > CareRight to see what works - it should allow you to log in to CareRight if you get it right
