There are now 3 pages where you can configure the code sets. These are:

- [Admin → Admission → Episode Diagnosis Codes \(ICD.D only\)](#)
- Admin → Admission → Episode Procedure Codes (ICD.P only)
- Admin → Patients → Diagnosis Codes (GEN or ICD.D only - defaults to global setting Diagnosis Code Type)

Configure ICD.P codes (ICD. Procedure)

Codes in this code set are available when selecting procedure codes on **Admission** and **Episode** records.

1. Click **Administration** from the top right corner of the CareRight screen.
2. Select **Admissions** from the left side menu.
3. Select **Episode Procedure Codes** sub-menu item.
 - a. The Episode Procedure codes display with the following values:

Code Type	This is the code type category - Procedure	ICD.P
Code	This is the code	31235-00
Description	This is the description of the Procedure code	Excision of lesion of skin and subcutaneous tissue of other site of head
Validity Date Range	The date range when the Procedure code is valid.	01/07/1998 →
Remove (Button)	This button allows you to remove a value

ICD.P	31235-00	Excision of lesion of skin and subcutaneous tissue of other site of head	01/07/1998 →	remove	
ICD.P	31235-01	Excision of lesion of skin and subcutaneous tissue of neck	01/07/1998 →	remove	

To Import a code /codeset

1. Enter a code into the blank field (e.g., 14224-00 or 108* — you can use * as a wildcard).
2. Leave the value **Import**.
3. Select the **Go** button.

To Remove a code /codeset

1. Enter a code into the blank field (e.g., 14224-00 or 108* — you can use * as a wildcard).
2. Leave the value **Remove**.
3. Select the **Go** button.
