

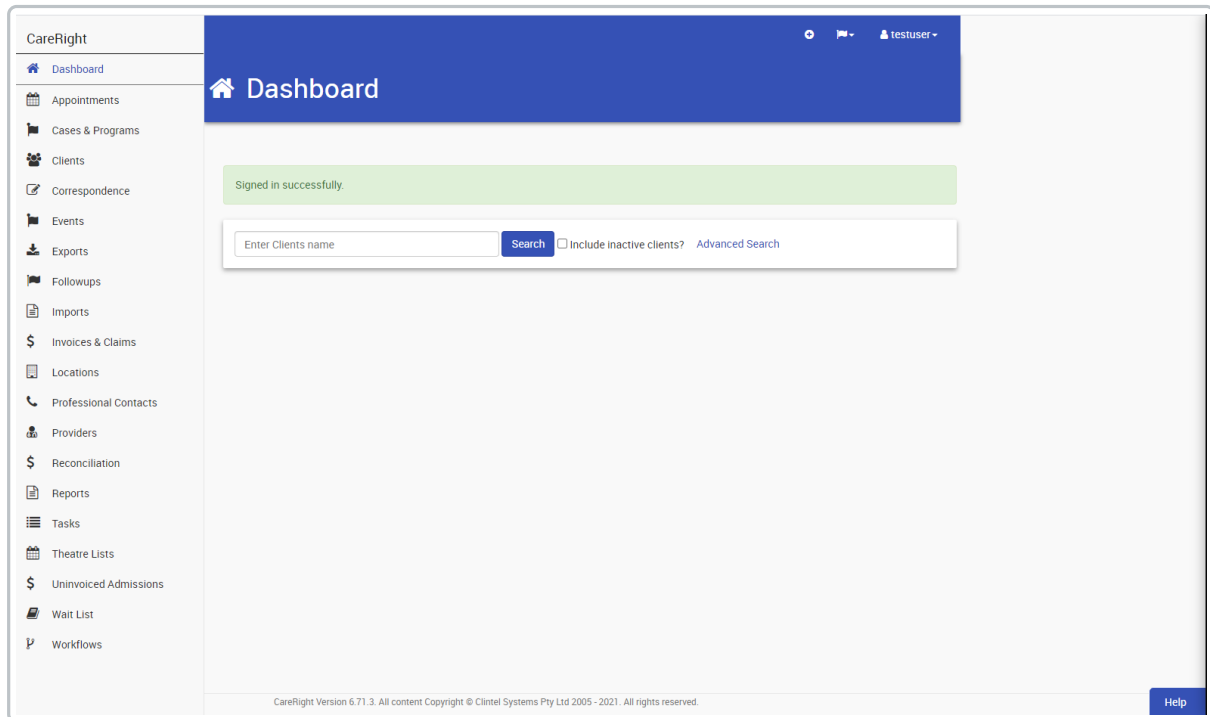

## Dashboard





This is the Very first tab where the user will redirect when they log in to CareRight.

## Configuring Dashboard

This Dashboard can be configured as the user preferences in the following ways,

1. Display/Hide most recent assessments which are not approved.
2. Display/Hide Workflows.
3. Display/Hide Today's appointments.

- a. Hide appointment notes - Users who enabled Display Today's Appointments can hide the appointment notes.
