

2. Location Configuration


In order to configure PCOC, you will have received a Service Identifier. This is set at the location level.

3. Set Provider PCOC Identifier


Dashboard> Providers> Add PCOC Team Identifier



4. Configure Person Field

Enable the Built-in Person Field PCOC_Diagnosis

Administration> Patients> Person Fields> Enable the field pcoc_diagnosis



5. Configure Admission Categories

Administration> Admissions> Admissions category, Set the below Data elements

- 1. Care Type: Palliative Care
- 2. Ensure the below fields are enabled;
 - a. Palliative Care Days
 - b. Palliative Care Status
 - c. First Admission for Palliative Care Treatment
 - d. Previous Specialised Non-Admitted Palliative Care Treatment
 - e. Coronary Care Unit Charges
 - f. Coronary Care Unit Days

6. Set Assessment to capture PCOC data
