

## ASL Consent

*Manage Active Script List upload consent:* If a patient has indicated they do not want their information uploaded into the Active Script List, you can manage patient consent. The default behaviour is consent is assumed.

### **Steps:**

1. **Dashboard > Patient**
2. Select **Medications**
3. Select **Access**

Prescribers will see an indication of ASL Upload Consent, and may elect to override it.
